President's Letter – Rob and Terri Sherwood

This letter to all CRDA members bridges the end of 2006 and a new year ahead. The board is pleased to announce that the November Gala attendance was 207 dancers, which broke the equivalent of 100 couples for the first time in many years. Several things likely contributed to this accomplishment, including excellent clinicians, growth of Round Dancing in Colorado Springs, and a continuing effort in publicity. Ongoing hard work developing the Gala warm-up Harvest Moon dance may have also been a factor.

January brings the beginning of our experimental Saturday evening mini-dances. There are two somewhat divergent goals driving this project. In the long run, CRDA would like to see more cuers take advantage of the publicity focused on Ballroom Dancing, and augment their beginner class programs to focus on ballroom rhythms. New ballroom dancers who do not learn two-step need a place to practice their budding skill. CRDA hopes to assist in filling this gap with a monthly Saturday evening dance. The other side of the coin is the fact that there are few weekend round dances. Dancing Penguins has two Friday party dances per month, and Jim's Dandies has one Sunday dance per month, both scheduled in halls that can handle over 10 couples. CRDA is carefully scheduling around these other opportunities for weekend dancing.

The first Saturday mini-dance will be held at the Rose Hill Grange in Commerce City at 7:00 PM on January 13^{th} . The second dance location has yet to be determined since we have not located a hall near Colorado Springs. The date will be February 10^{th} , with a fall-back location of Rose Hill Grange. March 10^{th} rotates the 7:00 PM dance to the Boulder area at Ed and Elvira Glenn's home, and their newly refurbished dance floor. The cuers will always adjust the level of dance to those in attendance. Cuers, if you have a 2^{nd} Saturday free, please let CRDA know when you can volunteer to support this project in the coming months. *(Continued on Page 3)*



CRDA BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

October 14, 2006

The meeting was called to order by Rob Sherwood at 10:00 a.m. at the Rose Hill Grange. The minutes were read and approved.

<u>Treasurer's report</u> - The treasurer's report was approved with the note that the \$100 from DACCA was not for the PSA but for the after the Gala clinic by the Fishers which has been cancelled. We need to reimburse them or roll the money over for next year when the Blackfords can do the clinic. Ben Moore has used his personal copy of Quick Books and he goes off the board next year. A motion was passed that CRDA purchase Quick Books for the use of the new treasurer and update it as necessary.

<u>President's report</u> – The PSA has been sent to 17 radio stations so far, most of whom wanted e-mail copies rather than the CD's which were burned. We will send it to more stations. Rob Sherwood requested that the Red Book be updated to reflect the practice that the president doesn't sign blank checks. Chris Cantrell noted that the Red Book update will begin after the by-law changes are finished.

<u>Vice President's report</u> – Patrick and Eileen Krause submitted the report on the Harvest Moon dance. The new sound enhancement equipment worked with some problems. 111 dancers danced to 14 cuers for a great dance. The nominating committee has two nominations for new board members: Justin and Rose Judd del Sol and Linda Miller and Rick Mallinger. They are awaiting a decision from a third couple.

<u>Round Notes</u> – Nancy Piechota will do the Round Notes through this year and hopefully Rose Judd del Sol will take over then. Nancy is to be commended for a job well done.

<u>Cuer Selection Committee</u> – Earl Smith and Judy Ashby have been appointed to the committee for 2007.

<u>Gala-</u> 71 couples have registered, with 53 signed up for the lunch. John and Karen Herr have agreed to host the Nelsons. A suggestion was made to put the registration table inside the hall Friday afternoon so that if extra help was needed, it would be readily available. \$22 was collected at the Harvest Moon dance for the hot dogs at the After Party on Saturday night which will be in the breakfast area of the Sleep Inn. Please bring a food item to share. A new feature this year will be a drawing for wooden fretwork at \$1 per ticket. Herman Allmaras suggested there be a survey on the evaluation forms asking for background, occupation, hobbies, dancing history etc. to learn more about our demographics. This form should be both in the syllabus and on the registration table.

Also a question on how much of the syllabus, such as the cue sheets, do you use?

The program is not finished because some cuers have not replied yet. Also the 5-6 teach is still unknown.

<u>Hall of Fame</u> – Everything is completed.

Membership - We currently have 128 members.

<u>CO State Square Dance Assoc Representative</u> – no report <u>Denver Area Square and Round Dance Council Representative</u> – no report

<u>Promotion and Publicity</u> – A meeting with cuers (Glens, Roy Knight, Chris Cantrell, Bob Lyons, John Herr and Patrick Krause) was held after the Round of the month meeting to discuss staggering lessons and other ideas. The cuers felt publicity was an important issue. Ideas included using free calendar listings in newspapers, and putting paid advertisements on Big Band stations (Rob Sherwood will investigate this.) The idea of having a Party Dance one Saturday night each month to encourage non-square dance dancers was discussed. It would be at a grange, possibly Rose Hill, Maple Grove or Wheat Ridge and information on it would be in the square dance bulletin and sent out via e-mail to Ben Moore's data base. A motion was passed that this be tried on a Saturday night for three months, January February and March, and be announced at the Gala. We should get the cuers schedule and who would be able to cue. It could be coordinated with classes, or have a 45 minute teach on mambo or cha, for example. There was also a discussion on single dancers and helping struggling dancers.

<u>Strolling Rounders</u> - This committee is working on getting all clubs visited before the Gala. It was suggested that the Strolling Rounders schedule be put on the web site with the note; "Strolling Rounders is visiting blank on blank date. Come along."

<u>Web Page</u> – Terri Cantrell continues to add to the web page, including Gala information, clips of instructors from URDA doing waltz and tango and two clips of party dancers, audio clips of the round of the month and a page for people to go if they have questions about the PSA.

<u>Unfinished business</u> – A motion was passed that we buy one recording box for the sound reinforcement feeds to have at the Gala. Chris Cantrell and Earl Smith each have one, but a third one is needed for three halls. A motion was passed to buy 1000 business cards for \$30 to \$50 to advertise CRDA.
