They have taken a very active part in CRDA. They served two years as President, one year as Vice-President and were the CRDA Treasurer for three years. In 1995 they were Assistant Chairman of the CRDA Gala and in 1996 took on the Chairmanship of the Gala. They served on the Publicity Committee for four years, the Hospitality Committee for three years, the Decoration Committee for five years and the Cues Selection Committee for one year. They have also served as the host couple when Rod and Sue Anderson were the featured cues at our Gala.

Many may not know that Harold and Cindy were responsible for the three dance floors at our Gala. They felt that too many of our new dancers and lower level dancers were not coming to the Gala because they had to sit out too many higher level dances. They felt that we needed a floor for Phase II and Phase III level dancers. This has resulted in many more new and lower level dancers attending the Gala. Some times their floor has more dancers than the higher level floors. We can thank Harold and Cindy for the larger turnout of these dancers.

They not only enjoy dancing at the two clubs they belong to, but they love to travel to other parts of the state to dance, as well as dances and festivals in other parts of the country. They also attend the National Square Dance Festivals where they enjoy round dancing to different round dance cues. They encourage other dancers to get out on the dance floor to learn new dances.

The CRDA Hall of Fame is an award that Harold and Cindy deserve for all the time and energy they have put into round dancing in the last thirty-three years. You can tell that round dancing is a very big part of their life.

President's Letter – Rob and Terri Sherwood

Another year has whizzed by, and here we are again with a new beginning. Some projects that began in 2006 will be fine tuned in 2007. Our first monthly dance was held on January 13th at Rose Hill Grange, and the board is pleased to announce that we had 19 couples in attendance. A “tip of the hat” to Chris Cantrell and John Herr for their fine cueing and dance selection. The mix of rhythms and levels was wonderful. Even though it was the coldest day of the Winter, the hall was almost at capacity.

We will be continuing to expand our advertising to attract new round dancers, as we can no longer depend 100% on square dancers to feed new members into our hobby. A listing in Craig's List has produced its first response, and we are just learning how to use the local web-based “Your Hub” which has replaced newspaper Spotlight ad space. The board may choose to buy some radio air time for the radio spot you heard played at the November Gala.

The second major project, which was discussed with cues at a recent Round of the Month Meeting, was augmenting our beginner's classes. Two things needed to change: stagger classes so they don't all begin at the same time, and to add some classes that emphasize ball room rhythms instead of two-step. Three Colorado teachers, Jim & Bonnie Bahr, John & Karen Herr and Chris & Terri Cantrell, are now offering beginner classes that start with some combination of Waltz, Foxtrot, Rumba, Cha, etc. The class schedule is an area that still needs work, so potential new dancers can start classes more often than two or three times a year.

The World Wide Web and e-mail has changed the world. Many CRDA members get Round Notes via PDF format as an e-mail attachment. This allows you to read it on your computer or print it out at your convenience. Not mailing so many issues of Round Notes allows CRDA to redirect money to projects aimed at growing our hobby, instead of spending it on printing hard copies and buying stamps. To keep you informed, CRDA is sending out e-mail reminders before all dance events. Even if you do not choose to get Round Notes via e-mail, please send Rob Sherwood or Terri Cantrell your e-mail address so you can be included in our e-mail list. Phone numbers and e-mail links are available at www.CRDA.net. If you did not receive at least one e-mail about the January dance, we need your e-mail address. When there is news to announce, it is no longer necessary to wait for the next issue of Round Notes to communicate with our membership.

Don and Peggy Hutchinson began square dancing around 1985 with the Cast-Offs. After watching round dancing at the square dances, they decided to take lessons from their cuer, Bob Lyons. Over the years they have danced with Good Time Rounds, Shade(y) Rounders, Dancing Penguins and Telemarks. Don and Peggy have been round dancing for 19 years and CRDA members for 15 years.

As members of CRDA, Don and Peggy have served on the Board of Directors for three years, including one year as vice president. They have also served on and/or chaired many Round Dance committees. They were chairmen for Gala, Spring Dance (two years), Strolling Rounders (four years), and also headed the CRDA nominating committee. They have served as assistant chairmen for the Gala and as members of numerous GALA and CRDA committees. Don and Peggy were also editors of the CRDA newsletter, *Round Notes*, for four years.

Currently, Don and Peggy are on the committee to develop Round Dance classes for the Multi Cycle lessons and are members of the Strolling Rounders. As busy as they are, they still find time to dance one to four nights a week and attend many dance week-ends.

When Denver has been the host city for any Round Dancing event, Don and Peggy have become actively involved. They have served on numerous committees for both USA West and the 53rd National Square Dance Convention.

Don and Peggy continue their service to round dancing as current CRDA Board Members. Their kind and friendly personalities and active involvement have served to promote round dancing throughout the area. In recognition of all their numerous contributions, CRDA is pleased to induct Don and Peggy Hutchinson into the 2006 Hall of Fame.

We need cuers to volunteer for the monthly dances, as not all the slots are full for those scheduled up through April. Of course, we also need dancers to volunteer to help at our three major dance functions, and the Spring beginner dance is not that far off on April 1st. Tasks are much easier with many helping hands, such as setting up tables and chairs, donating some cookies or snacks, or sitting at the registration desk to greet new dancers and old friends.

Finally, think about where you could post a CRDA business card at places you frequent. Many have bulletin boards that only require a card and a thumb tack. Let a board member know where you see these boards, be it at Starbucks, your recreation center, a book store or your church. We will never think of all of them on our own. It doesn't even cost a penny to get the word out in simple ways. If you have run out of cards, come to the next monthly dance or the Spring dance to refill your wallet or purse.

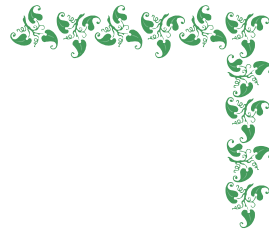

The meeting was called to order by Rob Sherwood at the Gala in Greeley. The minutes were approved as read. Ben Moore, treasurer, reported that we will more than break even on the Gala. Rob Sherwood reported that the Roundalab insurance is satisfactory according to Marsh Affinity Group Services.

The proposed by-law changes have been published twice in the Round Notes and also on the web. A copy was also provided on each table. Chris Cantrell, as head of the committee (consisting of Cantrells, Krauses, Sherwoods and Glenns) briefly reviewed the changes. It was established that a quorum was present. It was moved, seconded and passed that the by-law changes be accepted. One item not included in the changes was that in the event of dissolution, funds should be disbursed to a non-profit organization. This correction will be included in future changes.

Patrick Krause, head of the nominating committee, conducted the election of new board members. Don and Peggy Hutchinson, Roy and Marcia Knight and Ben Moore and Bonnie Douglas are going off the board. Justin Judd and Rose Del Sol, Rick Mallinger and Linda Miller, and Chuck, Melanie and Mitchell Thompson were nominated to replace them. There were no nominations from the floor. A motion was passed that the nominations be closed. The new board members were approved by acclamation.

President's Report - Rob Sherwood reported on our efforts to seek new dancers. He asked the members to give contact information so that announcements or ads could be placed in local newspapers. One couple showed up last night that found us on the web. The spring and fall dance will be in the same place next year. He thanked the outgoing officers for their work.

Round Notes - Nancy Piechota thanked everyone for their help and support. Rose Del Sol will be taking over the Round Notes

Cuer Selection Committee - Curt and Tammy Worlock and Paul and Linda Robinson have been selected to be guest cuers for 2009. Barbara and Wayne Blackford and Adrienne and Larry Nelson are cuers for 2007. Mark and Pam Prow and Judy and Hank Sherrer will cue in 2008.

Gala Report – Dennis Pluim thanked everyone for all their hard work, especially Peggy Pluim. Over 200 people have attended the Gala. Terri Cantrell gave the statistics of the program. 53% of the routines taught this year were on the program.

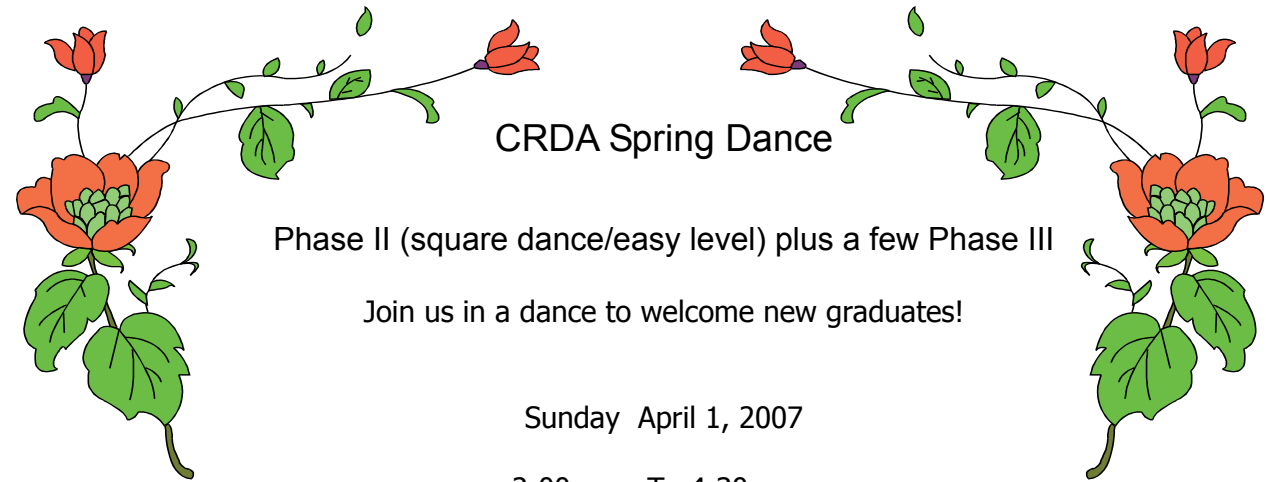
