

Parking is free at UNC on Friday and Saturday evenings and all day on Saturday. During the Friday afternoon session, parking on the street is free or you may buy a \$3.00 ticket from a kiosk in the parking lot. It is only good for open parking. The machine takes quarters and dollar bills. Or you may buy a \$3.50 pass from the Conference, Catering & Event Center in the University Center. (Do not leave your car unattended to go buy a parking pass, UNC security has been known to give tickets while you are inside buying the pass.)

#### **LUNCHEON/CRDA ANNUAL MEETING**

There is an optional catered luncheon at UNC on Saturday. The cost is \$13/per person. Since UNC wants a count for the luncheon on October 1st, pre-registration for lunch is required. If you would like lunch, you must pre-register for it and send the money to Patirck and Eileen Krause by September 30<sup>th</sup>. UNC has a very limited luncheon menu, and only one choice from the University's catering may be picked for everyone. So, if you have special dietary needs, you can either bring your own lunch and eat in the lobby area or go out to lunch in Greeley. #### **Gala Beat**

Our Colorado Gala is unique among state round dance festivals because we have three dance halls catering to all levels of dancers, from beginners to advanced. Our party dance on Saturday night provides an opportunity for all of our Colorado dancers, as well some of our dancing friends from nearby states, to get together at the same time, on the same dance floor. I really like the feeling of community that comes from dancing with all of our Colorado round dancers on Saturday night. However, this unique experience also presents some minor problems.

Since we program dances from phase 2 through phase 6, this inevitably means that some dancers will sit out some of the dances during the Saturday night party dance. This never bothered us when we were beginning dancers because we always enjoyed watching other rhythms, learning some technique by watching other dancers, and also being exposed to some slightly higher level dances that we just had to learn. Even today, as more advanced dancers, we still enjoy doing intermediate and beginner level dances, because they are nice dances, and they give us an opportunity to focus on our technique, rather than trying to remember basic figures. Personally, I really like the opportunity to do a few Two Steps. We never see them at advanced level clubs, and I like both the music and the feel of the Two Step rhythm. Finally, by the time Saturday night rolls around, many of us are tired enough that it is nice to have an excuse to sit out a few dances.

One of the primary goals of our program chairperson is to try to end the Saturday night program as close to 10 pm as possible, because people are tired from a long day of dancing, and many would like to attend the after party with some hope of getting to bed at a quasi reasonable hour. This is a difficult goal to achieve because there is always some uncertainty in the time that will be occupied by announcements, etc, but we usually end before 10:30.

In Colorado we are really lucky because our CRDA sponsors specialty dances for various levels throughout the year. I think that we are also lucky to have one dance per year where we can all get together, on the same dance floor, at the same time, for a couple of hours. I hope our CRDA members enjoy and appreciate the unique character of our gala and our Colorado round dance community.


