UNC has informed CRDA the price will significantly go up in 2011 and 2012. CRDA's board of directors formed a subcommittee to check into several possible venues to hold the gala, such as CSU – Fort Collins, CSU – Pueblo, CU – Boulder, DU, several hotels and convention centers. The subcommittee brought their findings to CRDA's board of directors. The board looked at all the options, and determined the best option is to stay at UNC. The other venues were ruled out due to carpet floors or hall size or price. Since CRDA will have to pay more for the hall rental, we would like to ask your support in attending the gala. Please encourage all round dancers you know to come to the gala.

This year's annual Gala will be at The University of Northern Colorado in Greeley on November 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>. There is round dancing for every level on 3 beautiful hardwood floors. The flyer is out and printed on the CRDA website. The 2011 Greeley Hall costs will be \$1050 for Fri. and \$1050 for Sat. for a total of \$2100. ## Gala 2012

A presentation of alternative sites was presented. The Board voted to stay at UNC because no other facility met our current needs nor did they offer any real savings on expenses. The hall costs would remain the same at \$2100 but a luncheon will be required. There will be a \$400 fee for the Panorama Room where the luncheon will be held and a \$1000 minimum catering charge plus an additional \$63.60 in taxes bringing the total luncheon cost to \$1463.60. The total UNC cost for 2012 will be \$3563.60 so a significant publicity effort will need to be made to bring in more couples if we are to break even.

## CRDA Hall of Fame:

We have 3 nominees, one completed application and another application on the way. Non-cuers need 150 points and cuers need 200 points.

## Fun Dances:

There is a scheduling conflict for the April Fun Dance and the Denver Square and Round Dance Hall of Fame Dance.

#### Membership:

We have 118 members and a final mailing for membership renewals is coming out soon.

#### Website report:

A facebook page is being developed. Dance opportunities that are not CRDA sponsored may be listed under special activities

#### Red Book Revision:

If you are a board or committee member, please read the sections in the operations manual that pertain to you and send a job description revision of what you do to Chris before the next meeting or a.s.a.p.

#### Old Business:

We need potential by-law change proposals submitted by May 15<sup>th</sup> for the June/July Round Notes publication. Proposals must be published twice in the Round Notes to be considered at the next General Membership meeting on Nov. 5, 2011 at the Gala.

#### New Business:

A discussion was held on how to promote membership in CRDA.

The next Board Meeting will be held on Sat. Aug 13<sup>th</sup> at Rose Hill Grange. Snacks are at 2:00 p.m. with the meeting starting at 2:30 p.m. Meredith and Terri will bring snacks. The Oct. 15<sup>th</sup> meeting will also be an afternoon meeting.

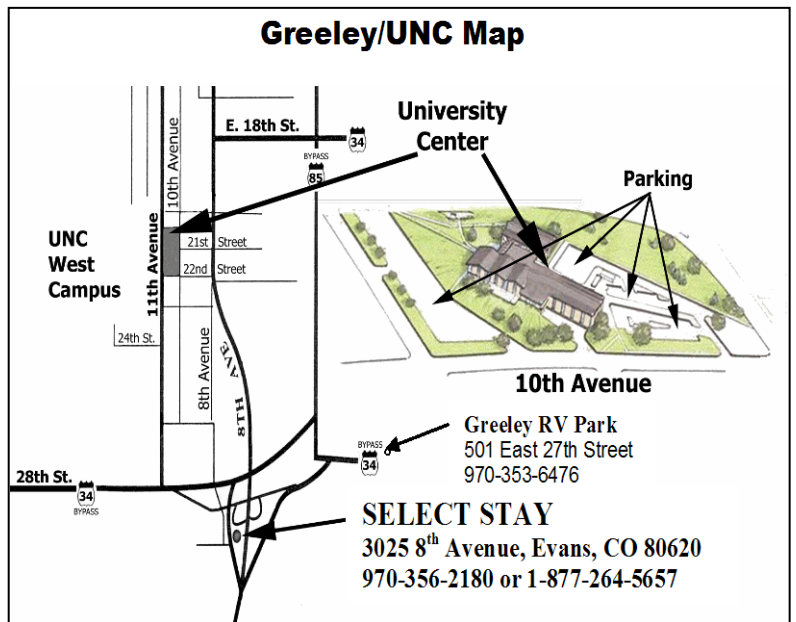

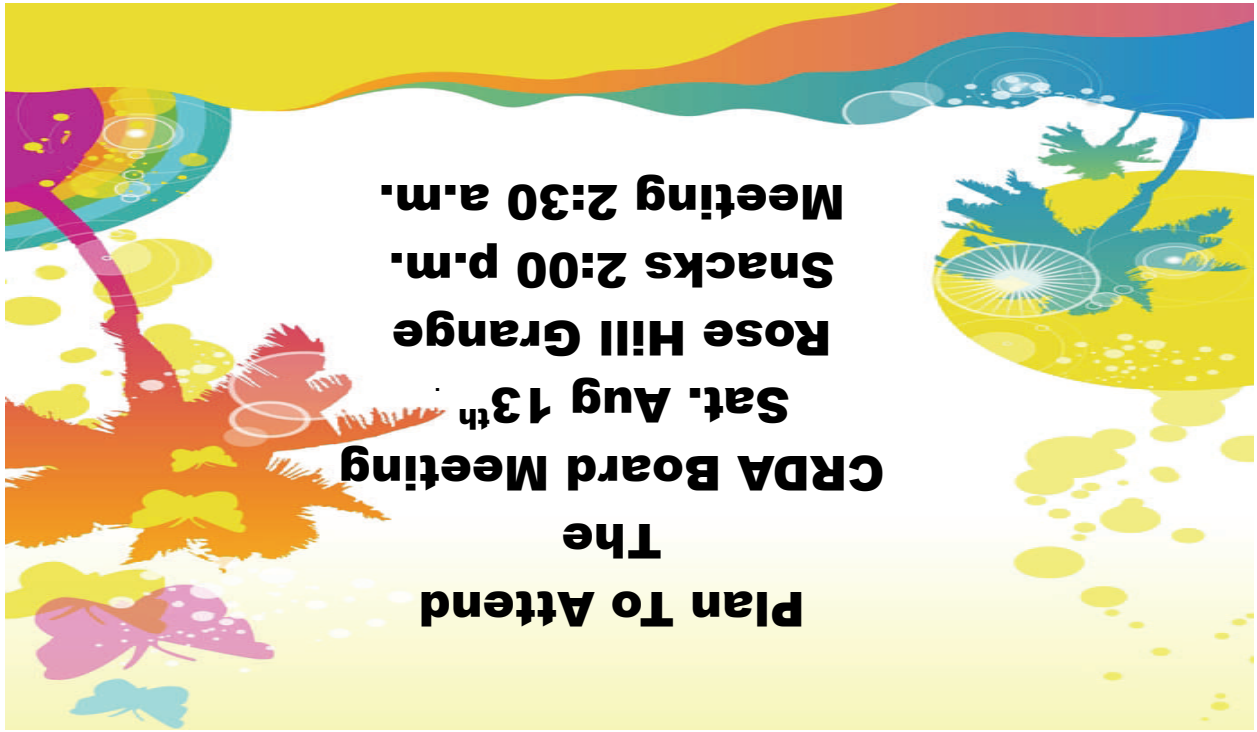
