TI & Bruce Chadd from Boise, Idaho and Kristine & Bruce Nelson from South Carolina will be our featured cuers. John & Karen Herr and Peter & Chama Gomez will be our clinicians. We are fortunate to have these great cuers and teachers for our Gala this year.

We are planning a Trail-In dance, teaches and clinics during the day on Saturday, and party dances on Friday and Saturday evenings featuring all phases of Round Dancing. The After Party will be at the host hotel.

The host hotel is the Baymont Inn & Suites (www.travelpueblo.com) located at 3626 N. Freeway Rd., just 2.8 miles from the Ballroom. Make your reservations now by calling the hotel at (719) 583-4000, and ask for the CRDA rate of \$65.00 per night. RV dry camping is available on the campus, and KOA is located just north of Pueblo. All meals are on your own. There are food options in the Occhiato University Center adjacent to the Ballroom, and there are many restaurants close by in Pueblo.

So, plan on registering at the door, and book your room at the hotel (\$65.00) soon to get the A flyer is included in this edition of Round Notes and you can go to good rates.

Things to Know for the 2018 Gala



Occhiato Ballroom Entrance

Directions to the Occhiato Ballroom

Please refer to the map next to the Occhiato Ballroom address on the Gala event page on the CRDA website, www.crda.net. Access to CSU-Pueblo from either direction is from Colorado Hwy 47, east of I-25.

From the West – Exit CO47 at Bonforte Blvd. Cross the bridge and at the University entrance turn right on Bartley Blvd. Follow Bartley Blvd. around the east side of the campus curving twice to head west to the University Student Center exit into the Ballroom parking lot. The Ballroom is on the east end of the Student Center. There will be CRDA GALA signs with arrows on Bartley Blvd to help you locate the Ballroom, plus the University has good directional signs to the University Student center.

From the East – Exit CO47 at Troy Ave. Head north on Troy Ave and turn left onto Alamosa Dr. Follow Alamosa Dr until it intersects Bartley Blvd. Turn right on Bartley Blvd and follow it north and west to the University Student Center exit into the Ballroom parking lot. The Ballroom is on the east end of the Student Center. There will be CRDA GALA signs with arrows on Bartley Blvd to help you locate the Ballroom, plus the University has good directional signs to the University Student center.

<u>Water</u>

CRDA will provide the dancers with a bottle of water at check-in. The water bottle can be refilled at the water fountains outside the ballroom using the water bottle faucet. Or, the dancers could bring their own water bottle and fill it at the water fountain. Water bottles can be taken into the ballroom (with a tight fitting lid) for easy access during the workshops and evening dances.

<u>Food</u>

Food choices are available at the University Student Center in the same building with the Ballroom. The cafeteria is open from 10:30 AM to 1:00 PM and 5:00 PM to 6:30 PM on Saturday. There are also many restaurants close by in Pueblo.

<u>RV Dry Camping</u>

RV dry camping in available in the parking lot next to the football field. Follow Bartley Blvd to Rawlings Blvd. Turn right on Rawlings Blvd, then left into the football parking lot. There will be directional signs on Bartley Blvd. There is no charge, and security will be aware that dancers may be camping there.

Baymont Inn & Suites (Host Hotel)

Please refer to the map next to the Baymont Hotel address on the Gala event page on the CRDA web site, <u>www.crda.net</u>. It is located on the Southeast corner of the intersection of I-25 and CO47. Book your room by October 1st to get the CRDA rate of \$65.00 + tax per night.

Registration

Register by October 1st to get the \$110.00 full package couple rate (singles half price), and remember that first time attendees get the \$80.00 full package couple rate (singles half price). So, register NOW!

<u>After Party</u>

There will be an After Party at the Host Hotel on Saturday night. Bring a snack to share and your own drink. Join the Nelsons and the Chadds for a chance to social with them and the other dancers.
